As you know, May 3rd is the last day for 2021 Governor's Scholars to accept or decline their nomination. It is also the deadline for Governor's Scholars to request a specific session due to scheduling conflicts.

As a reminder, there are three GSP sessions, and not all classes are taught on the three sites, therefore, requesting a specific session will take precedent over the selected class choices. These are the dates for the sessions:

June 20, 2021	First Session Move-in date
June 26, 2021	Second Session Move-in date
June 27, 2021	Third Session Move-in date
July 24, 2021	First Session Closing Day
July 30, 2021	Second Session Closing Day
July 31, 2021	Third Session Closing Day

Governor's Scholars commit to remain on the campus where they are assigned the entire five weeks without interruption.

NEXT STEPS

Once the Office of the Governor's Scholars Program has received the acceptances, the Campus Assignment Committee will work diligently to assign students to a campus and a Focus Area. To create the extraordinary community of learners that has characterized the GSP from its inception, students from the same high school will not be assigned to the same Focus Area group.

After the campus assignments are completed, the GSP-Frankfort Office will mail a packet of information which includes the campus and focus area assignment, as well as specific information applicable to the campus where they have been assigned. That packet will be mailed by but not before **Friday**, **May 21**st, **2021**.

Included in the packet will be information about Move-in date, what to bring (and not to bring), directions to campus, general rules and regulations and specific campus documents as required by the host campus.

In addition, there will be detailed contact information for your campus. Please notice that the specific GSP campus offices will open approximately two weeks prior to Move-in date and there will be a website dedicated to each campus, which you can reference before arrival. In the meantime, I would like to refer you to the following videos, recorded one year ago, which contain practical information traditionally shared with parents and scholars on Move-in date

during the welcoming ceremony. <u>Because last summer the GSP structure was modified to a</u> <u>one-week on campus, please disregard what is only applicable for last summer.</u> An updated version of these videos will be available closer to the 2021 Move-in date.
