## 1. Form(s) mailed today:

Today, we have mailed, via USPS, a document to each selected 2020 Governor's Scholar as follows:

If you indicated in writing last week your willingness to attend an on-site program if one is held, your document is titled <u>Permission and Release Form</u>\*.

If you indicated in writing last week your decision not to attend an on-site program if it is held, your document is titled Release Form\*.

If you did not answer our request last week, at this moment we are assuming that you are <u>not</u> attending and therefore your document is titled <u>Release Form</u>\*. In the event there is a misunderstanding on your part or ours, please follow the instructions in the form and notify us as soon as possible.

\*The Release Form is an authorization for the GSP to release your name to Kentucky's colleges and universities for the purpose of recruitment, enrollment and merit-based scholarships.

## 2. Campus and Focus Area Assignments:
