Noteworthy Alumni



Jen Price ('92) grew up in Hopkins County and graduated from South Hopkins High School in 1993. She attended Transylvania University, graduating in 1997 with a B.A. in Psychology, and then received her Ph.D. in Clinical Psychology from the University of Arkansas in 2002. She also completed a post-doctoral fellowship in clinical psychology at Dartmouth Medical School and the National Center for Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder. She was a Professor of Psychology at Georgetown College for 20 years prior to her current position with GSP. Jen was a scholar in 1992 at GSP-Murray and served the Program in various capacities from 1994-2001. She returned in 2004-2005 as the Director of Scholars, then took time off to raise a family. She served as an Associate Campus Director from 2013-2015, then as a Campus Director from 2016-2022, and has been the Academic Dean since 2023. At the close of the 2024 summer, she was named the fourth Executive Director of the Program, coming full circle in the GSP.
