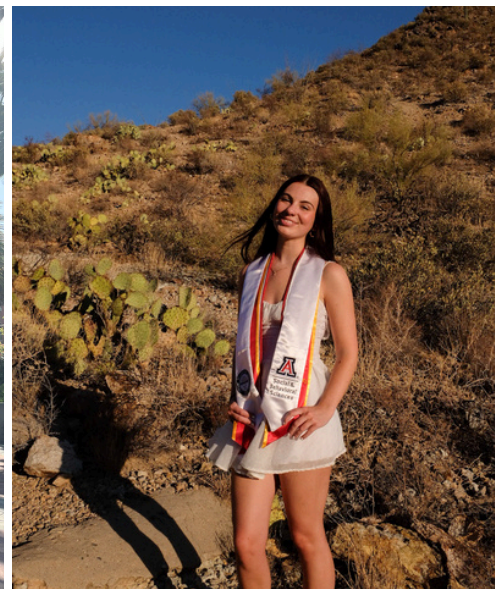
Ray, Clayton, and Bailey Jo Fesenmyer
